## **POSITION DESCRIPTION:**

- The Access Clinician determines financial eligibility and conducts the initial clinical screening process for regional mental health services and substance use services including assessing for crisis and suicidality
- This position collects demographic, financial and clinical information and inputs all data into the Electronic Medical Record system and the time of the call and transfers the record to the agency scheduler
- This position is part of a busy call center, answering calls coming into the Access for Behavioral Healthcare line
- The Call center is open Monday through Friday, 8:00 5:00 pm. No evenings or weekend work required

The hours worked in this position qualify towards licensure hours.

- Bachelor's Degree in behavioral science, counseling or related field, Master's Degree preferred
- Two (2) years experience in a mental health position
- Chemical Dependency Certification (CDP) a plus
- Call center experience strongly preferred

- Training in crisis and suicide intervention strongly preferred
- Able to maintain respectful, customer-friendly demeanor while working in a stressful call center environment
- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision
- Ability to work cooperatively as a clinical team member
