General Function:

This position provides information and referral to clients who are requesting outpatient mental health and substance use services at one of the community funded outpatient mental health and substance use providers that are contracted through the North Sound Behavioral Health Organization (NS BHO).

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's Degree required, Master's Degree in behavioral science, counseling or related field preferred
- Two (2) years experience in a mental health position
- Chemical Dependency Certification (CDP) a plus
- Agency Affiliated Counselor Registration is required within 30 days of employment, or equivalent, and must remain in active status during employment
- Crisis intervention and call center experience strongly preferred
- Training in suicide prevention and intervention strongly preferred
- Posses a strong understanding of the Regional Mental Health service delivery model
- Able to maintain respectful, customer-friendly demeanor while working in a stressful call center environment
- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision
- Ability to work cooperatively as a clinical team member
- Must have excellent written and oral communication skills
- Solid computer and typing skills as well as time management skills with attention to detail
- Raintree experience highly desired
- Demonstrated respect for diversity

Principal Activities:

- Review all voice messages left on the ACCESS line.
- Perform Follow calls to provide requested information and referrals.
- Handle calls efficiently by utilizing effective therapeutic skills and crisis intervention by conducting a risk assessment.
- Process and record all incoming on line application forms and routing them to the requested provider agency.
- Maintain high energy and a positive customer service attitude under stress
- Collaborate with interpreter services
