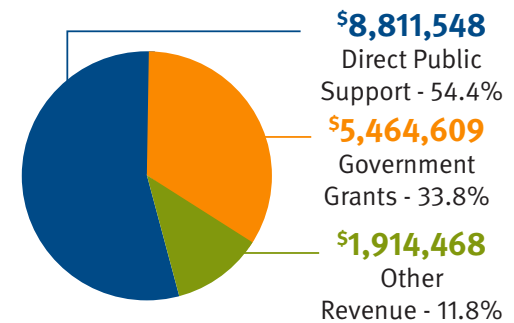

School this year looked entirely different. A lot of students face so much at home that the last thing on their mind is having school supplies. But this year was entirely different. They needed your support more than ever.

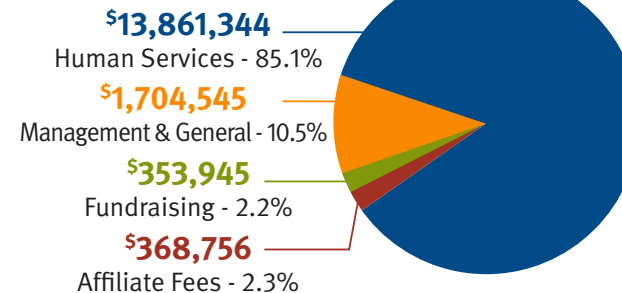
In the midst of a global pandemic, you showed up. You made sure students across Michigan had the tools they needed to succeed in these unprecedented times.
