\_\_\_\_\_ Volunteers agree to not serve if they are feeling unwell or have knowingly come in contact with a person infected with COVID-19 in the last 14 days.

\_\_\_\_\_ Must **ATTACH** proof of COVID-19 vaccine prior to first day of volunteering.
