	Must complete COVID screening questions upon arrival
	Must practice safe social distancing from clients and staff
	Understand that all VOA staff and <u>volunteers</u> are required to and have been <u>fully</u> vaccinated and <u>have received their booster</u> <u>when eligible</u>
	Understand that VOA cannot require clients to get the COVID vaccination/booster but do regularly offer clients access to vaccination/booster shots through VOA-sponsored clinics
	Must comply with all current city and state regulations
	Provide your own gloves and tools to limit shared items
	Agree to serve at your own risk and not hold VOA liable if you get sick after volunteering
	olunteers agree to not serve if they are feeling unwell or have knowingly come in contact with a person infected with COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
	Must <u>ATTACH</u> proof of COVID-19 vaccine <u>and, if eligible, the</u> booster prior to first day of volunteering.
