Personalized residential treatment and support for expecting mothers with substance use disorder and women with young children.

- Children stay with you, regardless of age
- Therapy to begin healing from trauma
- Medication-assisted treatment available
- Coordination of visitation with children outside of custody
- Employment and goal setting support
- CPS qualified parenting classes available
- Guidance to develop a birth plan
- Support to create a reunification plan
- Coordination of child care
- Classes for life skills, nutrition, and vocational training
- Family education on dynamics of addiction and more

Recovery doesn't stop after your stay, which is why you'll be eligible for transitional housing, providing a safe, stable place to live for up to two years with your children. You will receive individual and group continued support, and child care options allowing you to work or attend school.
